

TOWN OF GRIMSHAW

Bylaw No. 1094

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF GRIMSHAW IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING TOWN OF GRIMSHAW COMMUNITY STANDARDS BYLAW No 1065.

WHEREAS pursuant to the Province of Alberta Municipal Government Act, a Council may amend a Bylaw, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Grimshaw, in the Province of Alberta, has deemed it necessary to amend the Town of Grimshaw Community Standards Bylaw to include snow removal around fire hydrants

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Town of Grimshaw, in the Province of Alberta, IN COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That Section 3 of the Community Standards Bylaw No 1065 be amended by adding:
  - w) That every occupant and in case there be no occupant then the owner of every property in the Town of Grimshaw that has a fire hydrant located on the boulevard abutting their property, shall remove snow from around the fire hydrant within a 2 meter radius within a period of forty eight (48 hours) hours after every snowfall. Snow removed from around the fire hydrant shall not be shoveled or placed on any town street, avenue, lane or sidewalk excepting for businesses exempt pursuant to Section 3.v) (2) under Bylaw 1087.
2. That Section 7 of the Community Standards Bylaw No. 1065 be amended as follows:

Should any property owner, agent, lessee or occupier fail, neglect, or refuse to remedy the condition as directed by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer, or Authorized Person, the Town of Grimshaw may cause the work to be performed to remedy the condition and charge the costs of such work (a minimum charge of \$50.00) plus a \$30.00 Administration Fee as follows:


  1. to recover the same as a debt due to the Town, or
  2. to charge the costs against the land concerned as taxes due and owing in respect of that land and recover the costs as such.
3. Where any occupant or property owner violates or contravenes this bylaw, Sections 4, 5, 6 and 7 of Bylaw 1065 shall apply.
4. That this bylaw amendment shall take force and effect on the date of its' final passage.


