

NOISE CONTROL BYLAW #628
of the Town of Grimshaw

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF GRIMSHAW IN THE PROVINCE
OF ALBERTA TO CONTROL NOISE WITHIN THE TOWN
CORPORATE BOUNDARIES.

WHEREAS: under the provisions of Section 157 (1)(g) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter 246 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1970, the Council may pass a bylaw for the purpose of prohibiting, eliminating, or abating noise and;

WHEREAS: the Town of Grimshaw deems it proper and expedient to restrict and abate such activities, which give rise to undue, and unnecessary noise and;

WHEREAS: it is the intent of this bylaw to control noise which disturbs the comfort or repose of other persons in the vicinity of such property or generally within the limits of the Town.

NOW THEREFORE: the Municipal Council of the Town of Grimshaw, in the Province of Alberta duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. The Bylaw shall be cited as the Town of Grimshaw Noise Abatement Bylaw.
2. No person shall make, continue to cause, or allow to be made any loud, unnecessary or unusual noise which either annoys, disturbs, injures, endangers or detracts from the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of other persons within the Corporate boundaries of the Town of Grimshaw.
3. No person shall allow property belonging to him or under his control to be used so that there originates from that property any loud, unnecessary or unusual noise which either annoys, disturbs, injures, endangers or detracts from the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of other persons within the Corporate boundaries of the Town of Grimshaw.
4. Any person who contravenes any provision of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$100.00 (One Hundred) Dollars and not more than \$500.00 (Five Hundred) Dollars, or to imprisonment for a term of not more than 6 (Six) months.

This Bylaw shall come into effect the final day of passing.
