

Mile Zero Regional Multiplex Policy On Code Of Conduct

Mission:

The Town of Grimshaw endeavors to promote programs, events and activities which foster, promote and emphasize a positive, safe and rewarding environment for all persons within the Mile Zero Regional Multiplex facility.

In support of this mission, the Town of Grimshaw has developed this Code of Conduct for all those attending, utilizing or participating in activities within the Mile Zero Regional Multiplex facility. This policy sets minimum standards and expectations for the conduct of everyone. Everyone includes, but is not limited to, administration, participants, teams, coaches, referees, officials, spectators, attendees, parents, teachers, guardians etc.

Policy on Code of Conduct:

When utilizing the Mile Zero Regional Multiplex facility for, or participation in, all programs and activities, managed or allowed by the Town of Grimshaw everyone is responsible for:

1. Demonstrate good sportsmanship.
2. No foul, abusive, racial or derogatory language.
3. No disorderly conduct, physical or verbal abuse against patrons, employees or volunteers.
4. Clean up after yourself and treat the facility, equipment, and other users in a respectful manner.
5. Please be courteous to others, when your time is completed promptly leave, so the next group can have access to the space. It is the responsibility of the user group to end their rental in the allotted time. Anyone who continues to use the space after their allotted time will be billed and may forfeit any future dates in the facility.
